This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of student results in English to 'C or above' from 84% to 89%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving the NQR Reading Benchmarks in:
 - Prep from 40% to 80%
 - Year 1 from 62% to 80%
 - Year 2 from 56% to 80%

Our initiatives include

- Allocate additional curriculum planning time (through regular classroom release time) to have clarity and precision in English planning, moderation and assessment.
- Engage individual teachers in the instructional coaching cycle (ICC) with leadership team
- Support teachers to develop and use Learning Intentions (LI) and Success Criteria (SC) in every English lesson.
- Support teachers to implement the whole school approach to improve literacy, 'Teaching with a Literacy Focus (TWLF)', during English lessons
- Support teachers to:
 - complete an MSV (Meaning, Syntax and Visual) analysis when planning lessons
 - effectively teach literacy skills using 'Promoting Literacy Development' resources.
 - expand their use of LI, SC, TWLF in Mathematics and Science lessons
 - effectively teach reading and comprehension.
- Embed collaborative enquiry processes during staff meetings whereby teachers collaboratively review student work samples to identify the next steps in teaching and differentiate for all students.
